Big enough to offer endless cultural events, concerts, and nightlife, but small enough to be explored entirely by bike or on foot.

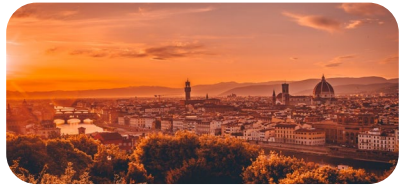
You will study in a vibrant, international environment, meeting students and travelers from all corners of the world.

Food & Social Life: From traditional trattorias and historic food markets (like San Lorenzo) to modern cafés and dynamic student aperitivos.



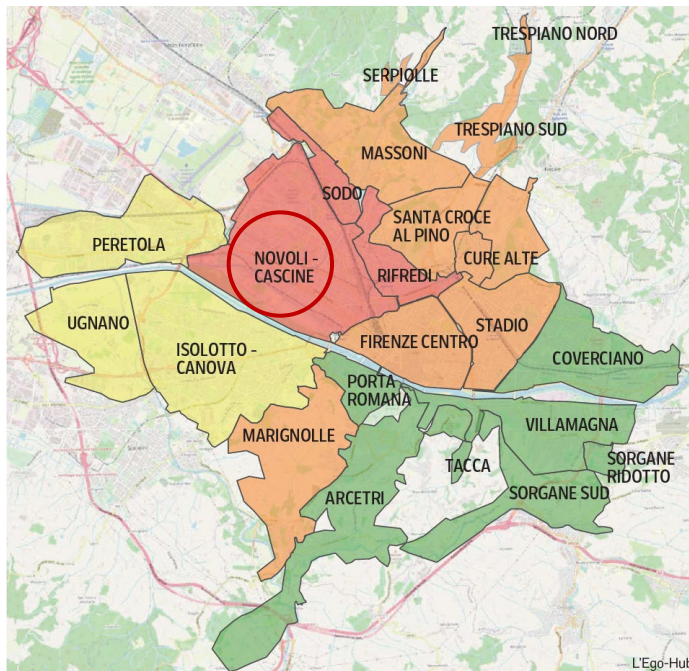
Green Spaces: Relax after classes in the Boboli Gardens, Cascine Park, or enjoy the best sunset view over the city from Piazzale Michelangelo.

Canteen

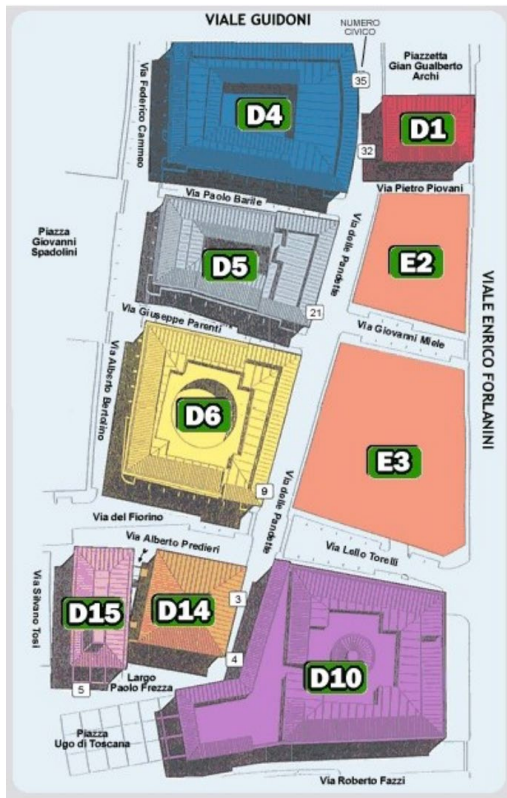


- The campus canteen offers students high-quality, freshly prepared lunches and dinners at affordable prices.
